BBM Facebook Frequently Asked Questions

How do I access the BBM Facebook Page?

Visit www.facebook.com. Enter <insert keywords for you Page name> in the Search Box at the top and you will see a drop down listing including our Page title. Click the title and you will be taken to our BBM Page. Once there, click the "Like" button at the top. This will allow all new postings on the BBM Page that are submitted by the BBM Page Administrator or your own Facebook "friends" to appear within your news feed.

Is this a public Page?

Yes. Anyone on Facebook can view and "Like" this page. Use this opportunity to share BBM with your family and friends who are not currently part of BBM. They may be inspired by what they read and explore becoming a BBM member. If they do not reside in our area, maybe they'll want to start a BBM program at their own church!

On a separate note, our Page administrators can delete any postings or ban a user from the Page should we experience any unexpected issues with the general public.

Can I post a message on the BBM Facebook Page?

Once you have "liked" the Page, you may post comments, pictures, or videos. You may post pictures from your BBM events, recipes from your group meetings, fun BBM or family outing ideas, inspirational quotes or stories, or anything else that may be of interest to the many moms in our BBM community. Please share your photos, stories, and ideas – often!

Is there anything I should NOT post?

For the safety and protection of our BBM children, please do NOT post any BBM pictures which include children that are not your own.

If I own a business, can I share my business opportunities/good deals on our BBM Page?

Yes, when applicable. You may post information that you feel is appropriate and would be of interest to the moms within our BBM community. Please follow these general guidelines when posting any business related messages:

- Post general information about your business up to five times during the BBM year.
- Post event invitations only twice per event. The first posting can be a few weeks or more in advance of the event, with one follow up reminder.
- Please do not email your BBM Group with business opportunities (with the exception of those who have personally requested to be included in your distributions).
